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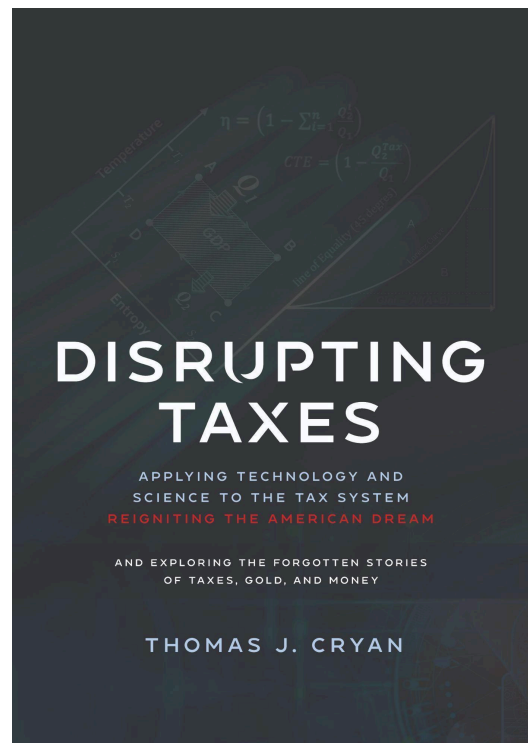

Exploring forgotten corners of U.S. history, Cryan offers a unique and comprehensive look at how tax policies were born of desperation and devised according to what was physically possible to collect—not what was mathematically or economically smart. In the tradition of “Freakonomics” Cryan explores the hidden side of the tax system through dynamic storytelling; offering an innovative technology-driven solution to modernize and simplify taxation, providing a thought-provoking discussion for history buffs and politically-minded Gen Xers and millennials whose very futures are at stake.

Since the shared tax sacrifice of World War II and the post-war 1940s, where taxes on individuals and taxes on corporations equally contributed to Government Revenues, through the decades that followed, there's been a dramatic shifting and increase in the tax burden onto individual salaries and away from corporate taxes. So much so that today taxes on individuals' salaries provide about 90% of Federal Revenue, and corporation taxes contribute less than 10% of Revenue. The implications of this shift for society and the future of the Nation is staggering.



Currently, roughly 150 million working people provide almost the entirety of the Federal Government's Revenue, while politicians and special interests have showered corporations with tax cuts to the point where they now contribute next to nothing. Cryan's visionary approach combines technology and science to create a new tax system with the potential to restore not only fiscal sanity but also financial equity—before it's too late.

Disrupting Taxes offers an engaging exploration of the tax system with an intriguing new solution and is divided into three parts:

1. **A history of government confusion and desperation regarding how to systemically collect taxes:** Cryan delves into the history of taxation, providing a fascinating glimpse of the arguments and dramatic events, such as the Civil War, that gave birth to rudimentary *Self-Declaratory* tax laws and policies that are still in use today.
2. **How we can use technology to implement a national Automated Banking Transaction (ABT) Tax:** Cryan introduces the ABT Tax, a revolutionary approach to taxation that leverages digital technology to tax all banking transactions within the economy at a tiny numerical rate, permitting the lowest tax rate possible by expanding the tax base exponentially, to the largest tax base possible, scientifically the most efficient system possible; where sufficient revenue is collected providing the ability to pay down the national debt before it becomes a national disaster.
3. **Faith as the single most critical aspect of modern money:** Cryan emphasizes how our modern system of banking and finance is built on faith, and the importance of creating a fair and effective tax system to restore shared prosperity, protect democratic institutions, and ensure the longevity of the American Dream.

"*Disrupting Taxes* is more than a book; it's a call to action to dynamically modernize our tax system and reignite the American Dream," said author Thomas J. Cryan, JD. Disrupting Taxes proposes a revolutionary change to the tax system that should be embraced by Republicans, Democrats, and Independents in that the ABT Tax is truly fair and equitable to everyone in the US society. The concepts and ideas within *Disrupting Taxes* are particularly timely, in that the current Trump Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, will expire at the end of 2025, and so with the new Congress, over the next 6 to 12 months, there will be many hearings and a great deal of discussion centered on what should be the framework of a new tax act.

Dynamically, *Disrupting Taxes* details a paradigm shift in taxes that bridges the socioeconomic divide for future generations while simultaneously charting a course to effectively pay down the over \$35 trillion in US national debt by extracting tax revenue from the broadest tax base possible—at the lowest tax rate possible—where everyone contributes a little, balancing the federal budget. It offers a solution to the cycle of Borrowing and Spending, which steals from our children's future to artificially support the economy of today.
